All items are visible from main streets within the City limits. Find the address, identify the building or location. Words in **bold** represent architectural terms.

1. A **Ramada** is a free-standing cover. *



2. A **Cantilever** is a projection without obvious supports.



3. This **spire** is made of concrete.



4. **Railings** provide fall protection.



5. **Columns** provide support on either side of an opening.



6. **Pilasters** are **columns** that are an integral part of a fence or wall.



7. A **Bell Tower** is a tall structure housing bells usually for a church.



7. An **Arch** is one of the strongest structural shapes!



8. A **balcony** is a platform off an upper level.



9. A **canopy** is a covering made of cloth.

*Hint- City boundaries include the corner of El Mirage and Camelback Rds.
