**Entries with the correct answers will be entered into a drawing for gift card prizes!**



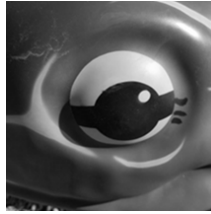
1. A sign announces this **adobe** building.

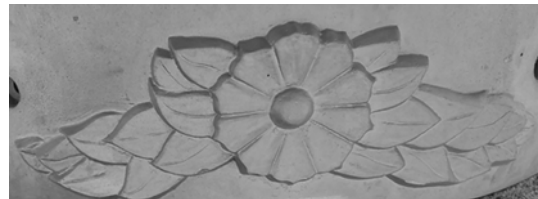
4. What year was the first church in Litchfield Park built?
